



2019 Catholic School Grant Program Terms and Conditions

Who can apply?

In order to apply, schools must meet one of the following requirements:

- Have at least 5% of their students enrolled in OCFCU's tuition payment program
- Have a minimum of \$50,000 on deposit with OCFCU
- Have a commercial loan with OCFCU

**Ohio Catholic can help you meet these requirements, if not already met.*

How to apply?

The school's administration (principal, president, etc.) must fill out an online application beginning April 1 through May 31. Applicants will be notified of their status during the month of July.

All schools who apply for a grant must specifically address the following in their short answer responses:

- What will the grant be spent towards (technology, outside educational programming, providing newer educational materials, etc.)?
- Why the grant is needed?
- How will the grant benefit the quality of Catholic education at the institution?
- What will be the anticipated outcome?

Schools are encouraged to provide additional material/resources that can assist Ohio Catholic's decision in awarding the grants. Examples of additional resources include links to information about technology, programming, or educational material the grant will be going towards, documents about the programming, etc.

The grant cannot be applied towards the following:

- Staff, faculty, or administrative salaries
- Travel expenses
- Any personal or individual use

After the grants are awarded, schools will be required to provide proof of expenditures and a quarterly report detailing the progress and outcomes of the program the grants were applied towards.
