

## 6/1/2018 – OCFCU Membership Eligibility

### **Those eligible for membership are:**

1. Employees, members, and students of a Catholic Diocese in the State of Ohio, including its parishes, schools, services, ministries, organizations, or entities.

Who is a member of the Diocese? The Catholic Diocese states that any person who is baptized as a Catholic and resides within the Diocesan boundaries is a member of the Diocese, regardless of whether that person is a member of a parish.

2. Members of the immediate family, or household of a person, as listed above.

Immediate family is defined as spouse, child, sibling, parent, grandparent, or grandchild, aunt, uncle, daughter-in-law, and son-in-law. This includes stepparents, stepchildren, step-siblings, and adoptive relationships.

Household is defined as persons living in the same residence maintaining a single economic unit.

3. Spouses of a person who has died while in the field of membership.
4. Employees, volunteers, or retirees of the Ohio Catholic FCU.
5. Members of the Ohio Catholic Foundation in Garfield Heights, Ohio, who qualify for membership in accordance with its first amended and restated bylaws in effect on April 11, 2017.
